

SEASON OF THE GREAT LENT MIRACLE AT CANA IN GALILEE

CHORBISHOP DOMINIC ASHKAR ALLAH YERHAMMO



Yesterday we received the sad news of the passing of Chorbishop Dominic F. Ashkar. He was born in Brumana, Lebanon, the son of a priest, Father Tobia Ashkar and his wife Rachide. He was proceeded in death by them, his two brothers, Emil and Faik, and his sister Abla. He is survived by his three sisters, Julie, with whom he lived for many years in the USA, and Nadia, and Caroline, his sister-in-law, Sileya, his nephew, Gergi, his wife Katia and his family.

Chorbishop was educated at the Maronite Seminary in Ghazir, Lebanon and was later sent to do studies in Catechesis in Paris, France at the Institut Catholique. He was asked by Patriach Peter Paul Meochi to come to the USA to serve the Maronites here. In 1966 he came to Saint Elias

Church in Birmingham, Alabama to serve as Assistant Pastor under Chorbishop Joseph Chedid. He was later sent as pastor to Saint Maron Church in Torrington, Connecticut, and then as Vice Rector of Our Lady of Lebanon Maronite Seminary in Washington DC.

In 1975 he was sent as pastor to Saint Maron Church in Youngstown, Ohio, where he served for eleven years. During that time, he also served for a brief time as Rector of Our Lady of Lebanon Shrine in North Jackson, Ohio. He authored several books as well as our first Maronite Catechism, which he entitled: Faith of the Mountain, now in its third edition, and soon to be revised again. He earned his doctorate in Islamic Studies from Temple University and authored several videos on Islamic - Christian themes.

In 1986 he was assigned as Pastor at Saint Maron Church in Cleveland, Ohio, and in 1987 as Pastor of Our Lady of Lebanon Church in Washington DC where he served for 31 years and built the parish church, classrooms and hall. Although his assignment there was completed in September 2018, he continued to write and also serve as Chaplain at the Arlington National Cemetery and as Chaplain at National Institute of Health. During his long and fruitful priesthood, he served as Protopresbyter, Director of Religious Education, and served on the Presbyteral Council. He will long be remembered as a priest who put his people first and himself last.

Chorbishop will be buried in Lebanon, but a wake and Divine Liturgy is planned for Our Lady of Lebanon in Washington DC. The Viewing is on Sunday, March 9 from 4:00 – 7:00 PM with Incense Service at 7:30 PM. Funeral Liturgy is on Monday, March 10, at 11:00 AM. Our heartfelt condolences to Julie Ashkar, and his family.

May he rest in God's peace.

OBSERVANCES

The Most Reverend Bishops Gregory Mansour and Elias Zaidan have issued the following Lenten guidelines for the Maronites of the U.S.:

- . All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine0 from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

Personal Devotion

Clergy, religious, and laity who wish to observe the more traditional Maronite practice of fasting and abstinence are encouraged to do so. That practice is summarized in the following, taken from the Synod of Mt. Lebanon (1736):

Every weekday of Lent (Monday through Friday) is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat and dairy products (eggs, butter, milk, etc.) Fasting involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat or dairy products. Dairy products are excluded because they are animal products. Saturdays and Sundays are exempt from fasting and abstaining as are the following feast days:, The 40 Martyrs-March 9, St. Joseph-March 19, and the Annunciation-March 25.


