BLESSED FEAST DAY OF SAINT JOSEPH

Saint Joseph is the husband of Mary and the earthly father of Jesus. He was a humble carpenter and was always said to be a protector of his family. Even though he was a humble and simple man, Saint Joseph comes from a royal lineage. According to Luke and Matthew's Gospels, Saint Joseph's origin can be traced back to King David.

When Saint Joseph found out about Mary's pregnancy, he immediately knew the child was not his but was still unconscious that she was carrying Jesus, the son of God, he wanted to divorce her silently. This decision to divorce Mary silently is something to be noted as very kind and caring. During those times, if a woman is pregnant with another man who is not her husband, it is customary to be stoned to death. He then also became an excellent father to Jesus as he treated Jesus as his own son. Saint Joseph is also known as someone who always obeyed

God's commands and lived a life faithful to Him.

In 2016, Pope Francis popularized the image of the Sleeping Saint Joseph. The Pope spoke about his devotion to him during his visit to the Philippines. He shared that he has an image of the Sleeping Saint Joseph on his desk for decades and that he places notes of some of his difficulties underneath it and asks him to intercede for his intentions.

You might be wondering what's so significant of an image of Saint Joseph sleeping. This has a powerful implication. In the Bible, God often spoke to Saint Joseph through his dreams. Here are the three particular times that it has happened. The first time was when he was thinking of silently divorcing Mary, and the angel appeared to him through his dreams. (Matthew 1:19-25)

The second time God spoke to him through a dream was when He told him to save Jesus from Herod. (Matthew 2:12-14)

Lastly, God spoke to Saint Joseph while

he was sleeping during the time Herod had died, and He wanted him to take Jesus to Israel. (Matthew 2:19-21)

Saint Joseph is the patron saint of many things. For one, he is the patron saint for a happy death, as his death is something that was not mentioned during Jesus' public life. It was implied that he had a happy death since he was in Jesus and Mary's close presence when it happened.

He is also the patron saint of craftsmen, engineers, house sellers, and working people. This is because Saint Joseph was a hardworking, honest man. He was a skilled carpenter who had much respect for his work.

Lastly, Saint Joseph is also the Universal Church's patron saint, fathers, expectant mothers, and families. We all know that he was the head of the Holy Family and was the guardian of Jesus and Our Lady's husband.

OBSERVANCES

The Most Reverend Bishops Gregory Mansour and Elias Zaidan have issued the following Lenten guidelines for the Maronites of the U.S.:

- . All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Lent.
- . Ash Monday and Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine0 from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

Personal Devotion

Clergy, religious, and laity who wish to observe the more traditional Maronite practice of fasting and abstinence are encouraged to do so. That practice is summarized in the following, taken from the Synod of Mt. Lebanon (1736):

Every weekday of Lent (Monday through Friday) is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat and dairy products (eggs, butter, milk, etc.) Fasting involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat or dairy products. Dairy products are excluded because they are animal products. Saturdays and Sundays are exempt from fasting and abstaining as are the following feast days:, The 40 Martyrs-March 9, St. Joseph-March 19, and the Annunciation-March 25.


